- **Frogging by Ear** – Learn to recognize your frog calls in the theatre at **12:30 p.m. daily** with the help of a skilled frogger interpreter and then go for a Marshwalk to listen for frogs and toads in the marsh.
  - **Birding by Ear Workshop** – Join a nature interpreter in the theatre at **2 p.m. daily** for a fun and interactive way to recognize your bird calls followed by a walk in the marsh to try out your birding by ear skills.

- **Birding Marshwalk** – **select times during the day** – Let an experience naturalist guide you through the many trails of Oak Hammock Marsh. This guided walk is approximately 1 hour in length.
  - **Canoe Adventures** – **select times during the day** - Explore the marsh and listen to the sounds of the marsh as you paddle in one of our 3 Voyageur-style canoe for a 45 minute to one-hour excursion. Extra fee of \$3 for non-members of the Interpretive Centre and \$2 for members apply for this ride.
  - **Films and Slide Show** - Enjoy nature films and slide presentations offered at select times throughout the day from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the comfort of our 120-seat multimedia theatre.
  - **Critter Dipping** – **all day** - Equipped with a net and a plastic bucket, try to catch some invertebrates in the waters of the marsh from on our floating boardwalk.
  - **Face Painting** - **select times during the day** - Have your favourite animal painted on your cheeks by one of artistic nature interpreters.
