BLUEBILL DECOY



Learn to carve your very own bluebill (lesser scaup) decoy from award winning carvers Harry Williams, Ross Gage and John Frye. This three day course will teach you the classic North American art of decoy carving.

The head and tail will be carved from white pine while the body, from a special watertight bonded cork. The decoy will be fitted with glass eyes, ballasted keel and painted with oil colours to represent a drake bluebill. Self-righting, the decoy is designed to float like a duck on the big, often rough, water of Manitoba lakes.

There will also be a informational session at the beginning of the course to learn about bluebill biology and hunting tips. Coffee and light snacks will be provided.
