## Fish

The fish survey done to give us an idea of what species occur at the marsh. The status of fish populations is strongly linked to the health of habitats that meet their needs. As these areas deteriorate or disappear, associated populations also decline. In Manitoba we have approximately 84 species of freshwater fish.

The survey is done Wednesdays at 3 pm, when fish are active from mid-May to mid-September.
