



# Labour Day Adventure

## September 6 – Event List

- **Horse-Drawn Wagon Rides - 12:30 to 4:30 p.m.** - Explore some lesser known parts of the marsh with Allan Webb and his horse-drawn wagon. Listen to the many stories he has to share. Extra fee of \$4 for non-members of the Interpretive Centre and \$2 for members apply for this half-hour to forty-five minute ride.
- **Geocache Workshop - 2 p.m.** - Come and learn what GPS is and how to use it and then try geocaching. Locate a new geocache in the marsh using GPS and leave something in it for 2011 visitors. Also try finding official Oak Hammock Marsh geocaches.
- **Compass Orienteering - select times throughout the day** - Learn how to use a compass and then take a navigational walk through the marsh to look for treasure.
- **Adventure movies - select times throughout the day** - Watch adventure movies in our Theatre.
- **Canoe Adventures - select times throughout the day** - Explore the marsh and listen to the sounds of the marsh as you paddle in one of our three Voyageur-style canoes for a 45-minute to one-hour excursion. Extra fee of \$4 for non-members of the Interpretive Centre and \$2 for members apply for this ride.
- **Marshwalks - select times throughout the day** - Let an experienced interpreter guide you through the many trails of Oak Hammock Marsh. This guided walk is approximately one hour in length and binoculars are provided to observe migrating birds.
- **Microvideo presentation - 1 p.m.** - See up-close what is on a duck's dinner menu as they prepare to migrate.
