

Welcome to the Oak Hammock Marsh Interpretive Centre Newsletter. Here are some upcoming and noteworthy events happening this month.

Migration Festival

October 1 & 2

The fall migration at **Oak Hammock Marsh** is truly unforgettable with hundreds of thousands of birds using the marsh as a staging area in preparation for their long journey south.



Participate in the Migration Challenge on **Sunday from 1 to 4 p.m.** and meet **Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries' IMPACT Ambassador and Olympic Medallist Janine Stephens**. We will be giving away beautiful cedar bird feeders supplied by **Wild Birds Unlimited** to the first 100 families who complete the **Migration Challenge**.

On Sunday, meet dozens of colourful parrots from the **Parrot Club of Manitoba** from 12 to 4 p.m. and **Koko**, the live burrowing owl from the **Manitoba Burrowing Owl Recovery Program** also from 12 to 4 p.m.

Learn all about songbird banding with our Resident Naturalist, **Paula Grief**. Watch how the small songbirds are caught in mistnets, carefully retrieved and banded with expert hands on both Saturday from 10 a.m. to noon and Sunday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Capture the marsh with your lens on Saturday at 2 p.m. and join our Migration Edition of our **Photo Walk Workshop**. Bring your camera (SLR, point and shoot or even your smartphone) and explore the many photogenic areas of the marsh. The fall migration offers many great photo opportunities! Pre-registration required, \$10 per person.

Explore the marsh by **horse-drawn wagon rides** this weekend from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m. The wagon ride is available for \$5 per person (\$3 for members of the Interpretive Centre).

Make sure to stay for the nightly fly-in of the geese from the rooftop observation deck!

Oak Hammock Marsh Interpretive Centre invites you to join us for our **Annual Birdseed Sale**.

Stock up on birdseed, supplied by **Pick Of The Birds**, on all three days from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. or make your very own pine cone bird-feeder to help out our feathered friends this winter.



This weekend is also your last chance of the season to enjoy the horse-drawn wagon ride experience with **Allan Webb** on **Sunday and Monday** from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m. Listen to his many stories and watch the birds as you explore some lesser known areas of the marsh. A fee of \$3 for members of the Interpretive Centre and \$5 for non-members apply to this forty-five minute ride.

With tens of thousands of waterfowl at the marsh, this is a great time to come see the geese and ducks before they all leave for the winter.

Gene Walz Book Signing


October 15 - 1 to 3 p.m.
