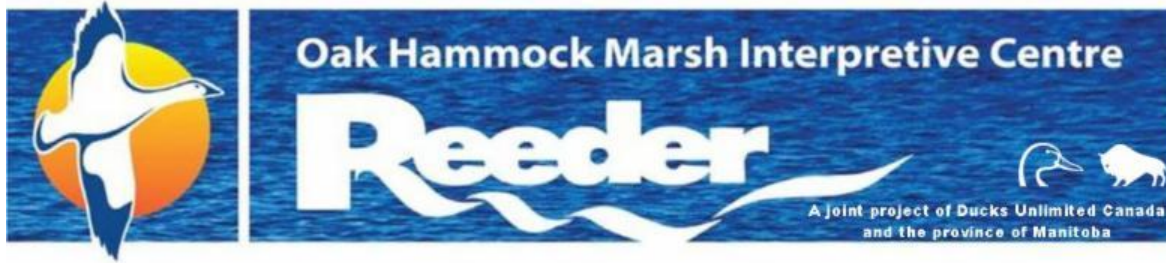

Are you planning a trip to the Caribbean this winter? Would you like to know what those melodious and colourful tropical birds at the resort are?

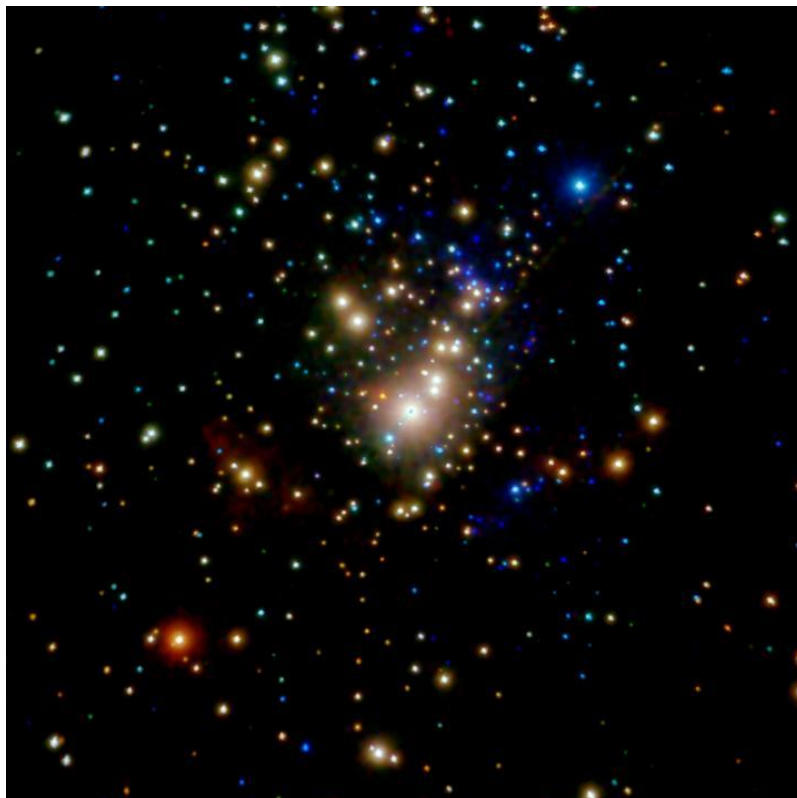
Join our Resident Naturalist, Paula Grief, to learn about the many birds that call the Caribbean home.
